Susan specializes in federal income tax laws that apply to the sale of timber for accountants, landowners, farmers, loggers or anyone that has sold or purchased trees.

Range of info on topics involving your potential taxes on the money earned by buying and selling timber:

- How to keep more money in your pocket and pay less in taxes.
- Also covered will be the myths common in the forestry and accounting communities, and how capital gains are treated with the purchase and sale of timber.
- Valuable tips on how some loggers can drastically reduce their regular income tax liability.
- How some landowners may be able to pay no taxes on their timber sale Revenue.

Also covered:

- Programs available for landowners to participate in to reduce taxes on forested property (QFP & CFA)
- Programs available to help landowners with the cost of Forest Management Plans (EQIP & SFP)
- Program that pay you to allow hunters access to hunt on your property (HAP)
