



ARKANSAS BLACK APPLE

A small to medium size red apple that matures into a deep purplish-red color that may have an appearance of being almost black in color. The Arkansas Black Apple is believed to be a direct descendant of the Winesap apple. The yellow flesh is firm and crisp providing a tart aromatic flavor. Can remain fresh flavored when kept in cold storage, this variety will keep for 6 months if stored and refrigerated properly.
