



ELEPHANT HEART PLUM

Elephant Heart plum's given name is a direct reference to its shape, heft and its coloring. It, indeed, has a heart shape and when ripe, is heavy in the hand, full of juice and the flesh, flushed with deep ruby red coloring throughout. The Elephant Heart plum has a mottled pistachio and purple skin, deepening to purple red with a powdery finish, when ripe. Its flesh is tender firm, succulent and sweet with just a hint of acid. Elephant Heart plums yield a short shelf-life when ripe. The Elephant Heart plum requires pollination from other cultivars as it is not self-fertile.
