NORTHERN RED OAK

The fastest growing of our native hardwoods with sharply toothed, 7-11 lobed leaves, turning red in autumn. Attaining heights of 60' to 80' with a trunk 3' or more in diameter. Prefers well-drained clay to loam sand with full sunlight. Often planted for wildlife, aesthetics and timber production. The wood is generally used for furniture, millwork and veneer.
