WHITE CEDAR

An evergreen tree, which typically grows in cold, poorly drained swamps with moving water. Will not tolerate acidic soils as good as it does basic soils (pH 7 or above). Very shade tolerant, very slow growing and short lived. One of the most important winter foods for deer. Is very effective for hedges and windscreens once established.
