Cornus stolonifera

Identification tips:

Leaves: Opposite with venation parallel to edge

Fruit: White berry

Twig: Red in winter; white pith



Redosier Dogwood

About this shrub:



- Fruit eaten by cardinal, ruffed and sharptail grouse
- Prefers sandy to clay soils; does well on moderately wet soils
- Grows 7 to 10 feet tall; 6 to 8 feet wide
- Hardiness zone 3
- Cultivars: Mason, Ruby
